- The Detroit Region is the Global Epicenter of Mobility hosting automotive operations from 26 OEMs, 96 of the top 100 suppliers, and 10 assembly plants producing 1.9 million vehicles annually.
- Michigan leads the U.S. in announced EV investments at \$16.6 billion, creating 16,300 new jobs (ranked #3 in EV job creation).
- The state drives \$14 billion annually in mobility and automotive R&D, accounting for 66% of the U.S. total.

- Michigan is committed to achieving 100% clean energy by 2040.
- The state leads the Midwest with nearly 124,000 clean energy jobs.



 With 2.6 million workers, the Detroit Region's workforce is larger than the working population of 28 other states.


SKILLS

The Detroit Region's top-notch universities and community colleges support a highly educated, dynamic workforce that offers stability and adaptability.


- More than 240,000 students are enrolled in the 9 community colleges, 13 specialty colleges/institutes and 12 universities in the region.

he Detroit Region's robust real estate market offers a wide range of buildings, land, and expert development partners to support industrial growth. Whether establishing a sales and warehouse operation or building a custom manufacturing facility, the region provides the resources and infrastructure to meet diverse business needs.

Detroit is the 8th largest industrial real estate market in the U.S., boasting 600 million square feet of occupied industrial space. A combination of local and national developers continuously bring new industrial space to market, with more than 3.7 million square feet currently under construction.

The region is also home to several leading industrial engineering, construction, and development partners, each with nearly a century of experience delivering innovative, on-time, and budget-friendly solutions for

manufacturing and logistics clients locally and globally.

To further streamline expansion efforts, the Detroit Regional Partnership's Verified Industrial Properties program (VIP by DRP) brings these resources to the forefront. This program accelerates site selection and helps companies quickly secure a location. The VIP by DRP team proactively identifies and assesses sites, making relevant site diligence and drone videos available through its Property Portal.

Once a site is selected, VIP by DRP offers an additional \$100,000 in site diligence support to expedite site plan reviews and construction schedules.

With a combination of strategic infrastructure, experienced partners, and innovative programs like VIP by DRP, the Detroit Region is the ideal destination for industrial growth and development.




